Joint Rec Committee and Friends of Reid State Park July 6, 2023

1. Pavilion Fee

Jim proposed that the Rec Com and Friends of Reid split the \$150 cost of renting the Pavilion 50/50. The Rec Com members agreed and said they would bring it to a vote at their next meeting.

2. Utilization of the Pavilion space and lawn.

- Board sign at start of pavilion path to specify Art Show/ Fall Frolic.
- Kids Art Table near Pavilion
- Art Show inside Pavilion
- Barbeque outside on lawn
- Game Area on lawn
- Move picnic tables outside for eating area on lawn
- Oyster growers table on lawn
- Garbage and Recycling bins on lawn

3. Tickets

Tickets for the event need to be passed out ahead of time as well as near gate that day. Last year the tickets were coordinated with Gary Best, State Park Southern Regional Manager via a Citizen Support Agreement (CSA). Last year the cost of printing tickets was donated. There was discussion of keeping ticket costs down by printing ourselves. We will discuss with Haylee whether the State can support the printing.

4. Publicity

Timing for publicity is important so that the word gets out early, especially for the Fun Run participants.

Joyce and Aria will coordinate on creating a poster and digital flyer that advertises the joint event and that can be circulated. As with the tickets, we will work with Haylee to see if the State can support printing.

5. Refreshments

Sign Up Genius will be used like last year for people to sign up to bring ice, hot dogs, drinks, baked goods, etc. Most of the food will be donated.
Possible sampling and demonstration by local oyster farmers.

6. Door Prizes

Raffle tickets will be given out for door prizes. People do not need to be present to win.

7. Fun Run/Walkers

If tides work out, part of the fun run route will be on the beach, otherwise on the road.
10 am start time probably.

8. Georgetown Fire Dept and Rescue will be booked by the Rec Com.

9. Event Volunteers will be solicited for directing traffic, cooking, clean up, etc.
